Genesis 25:21-26

1) HAD BEN PRAYED FOR

Genesis 25:21-22 “*Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife.....So she went to inquire of the Lord.*”

2) HAD BEEN PREDICTED ABOUT

Genesis 25:23 “*And the Lord said to her: “Two nations are in your womb, two peoples shall be separated from your body; one people shall be stronger than the other, and the older shall serve the younger.”*”

3) HAD BEEN PLANNED OUT

Romans 9:11 “*That the purpose of God according to election might stand*”

II. THEIR “DIFFERENCES”

Genesis 25:27-28

1) A MAN’S MAN vs. A MILD MAN

Genesis 25:27 “*So the boys grew. And Esau was a skillful hunter, a man of the field; but Jacob was a mild man, dwelling in tents.*”

2) THE FATHER’S FAVORITE vs. MAMA’S BOY

Genesis 25:28 “*And Isaac loved Esau because he ate of his game, but Rebekah loved Jacob.*”

3) REGRET vs. REPENTANCE

2 Corinthians 7:10 “*For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.*”

III. THEIR “DESTINATIONS”

Malachi 1:2-3 “*Yet Jacob I have loved; but Esau I have hated*”
